



Wind Restraints

When it is really windy or blustery you may want to secure the front end of the Bumperchute with the wind restraint lines located on the inside face of the brow (where it says COMMAND POST). On each side there are guy lines and bumper hooks wrapped up and secured with velcro.

Connect the hook end of the cord to the rear bumper. Adjust the cord length by drawing line through the cord lock. Cinch it down and that will keep the front (top white section) from lifting off.
